**"AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO CERTAIN DEPARTMENT
OF PUBLIC HEALTH STATUTES."**

8 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
9 internal references accordingly:

10 "Sec. 501. Subsection (e) of section 20-12 of the general statutes is
11 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
12 *passage*):

13 (e) Any physician licensed in another state [whose] who is board
14 certified in pediatrics or family medicine, or whose state standards for
15 licensure are equivalent to or greater than those required in this state,
16 may practice as a youth camp physician in this state without a license
17 for a period not to exceed nine weeks.

18 Sec. 502. Subsection (c) of section 20-195o of the general statutes is
19 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
20 *October 1, 2003*):

21 (c) Each person licensed pursuant to this chapter may apply for
22 renewal of such licensure in accordance with the provisions of
23 subsection (e) of section 19a-88. A fee of one hundred fifty dollars shall
24 accompany each renewal application. Each such applicant shall furnish
25 evidence satisfactory to the commissioner of having participated in
26 continuing education. Any applicant who fulfills the continuing
27 education requirements for a professional educator certificate as
28 provided in chapter 166 shall be deemed to have fulfilled the
29 continuing education requirements pursuant to this section. The
30 commissioner shall adopt regulations in accordance with chapter 54 to
31 (1) define basic requirements for continuing education programs, (2)
32 delineate qualifying programs, (3) establish a system of control and
33 reporting, and (4) provide for waiver of the continuing education
34 requirement for good cause.

35 Sec. 503. Section 19a-421 of the general statutes is repealed and the
36 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

37 (a) No person shall establish, conduct or maintain a youth camp
38 without a license issued by the department. Applications for such
39 license shall be made in writing at least thirty days prior to the
40 opening of the youth camp on forms provided and in accordance with
41 procedures established by the commissioner and shall be accompanied
42 by a fee of six hundred fifty dollars or, if the applicant is a nonprofit,
43 nonstock corporation or association, a fee of two hundred fifty dollars
44 or, if the applicant is a day camp affiliated with a nonprofit

45 organization, for no more than five days duration and for which labor
46 and materials are donated, no fee. All such licenses shall be valid for a
47 period of one year from the date of issuance unless surrendered for
48 cancellation or suspended or revoked by the commissioner for
49 violation of this chapter or any regulations adopted under section 19a-
50 428 and shall be renewable upon payment of a six-hundred-fifty-dollar
51 license fee or, if the licensee is a nonprofit, nonstock corporation or
52 association, a two-hundred-fifty-dollar license fee or, if the applicant is
53 a day camp affiliated with a nonprofit organization, for no more than
54 five days duration and for which labor and materials are donated, no
55 fee.

56 (b) Failure to submit the application and licensing fee at least thirty
57 days prior to the opening of the youth camp shall result in a civil
58 penalty of not more than one hundred dollars per week for each week
59 the camp fails to submit the application and fee."
