"AN ACT CONCERNING MINIMUM ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS."

1 Strike lines 33 to 38, inclusive, and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "(10) "Unit heater" means a self-contained, vented fan-type
4 commercial space heater that uses natural gas or propane that is
5 designed to be installed without ducts within a heated space. "Unit
6 heater" does not include a product regulated by federal standards
7 pursuant to 42 USC 6291, as amended from time to time, or a product
8 that is a direct vent, forced flue heater with a sealed combustion
9 burner;"

10 In line 171, after "2005," insert "except for ceiling fans, ceiling fan
11 light kits, and large packaged air-conditioning equipment, for which
12 the date shall be July 1, 2008,"

13 Strike lines 195 to 207, inclusive, and insert the following in lieu
14 thereof:

15 "[(h) The commissioner shall cause periodic inspections to be made
16 of distributors or retailers of new appliances covered by subsection (b)
17 of this section in order to determine compliance with the provisions of
18 this section. The commissioner shall cause investigations to be made of
19 complaints received concerning violations of this section and shall
20 report the results of such investigations to the Attorney General.]

21 (h) The Attorney General may institute proceedings to enforce the
22 provisions of this section. Any person who violates any provision of
23 this section shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than two
24 hundred fifty dollars. Each violation of this section shall constitute a
25 separate offense, and each day that such violation continues shall
26 constitute a separate offense."
