"AN ACT CONCERNING INVESTIGATIVE SUBPOENAS."

1 Strike subsection (a) of section 9 in its entirety and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(a) Whenever a subpoena has been issued to compel the
4 appearance and testimony of a witness or the production of property
5 pursuant to sections 1 to 12, inclusive, of this act, the person
6 summoned may, within three working days after the date scheduled
7 for such person's appearance, file a motion to quash the subpoena with
8 the clerk of the court for the judicial district as provided in section 5 of
9 this act. No fees or costs shall be assessed."

10 Strike subsection (c) of section 9 in its entirety and substitute the
11 following in lieu thereof:

12 "(c) The motion, upon its filing, shall not be sealed as to the public.
13 The motion shall be referred to the presiding criminal judge of the

14 court for hearing or for assignment to another judge for hearing.
15 Unless otherwise ordered by the judge conducting the hearing, the
16 hearing shall be conducted in camera and the file on the motion shall
17 not be sealed as to the public, subject to further order of the court."
