    - 6 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) (a) There is established a
    - 7 DNA Data Bank Oversight Panel composed of the Chief State's
    - 8 Attorney, the Attorney General, the Commissioner of Public Safety
    - 9 and the Commissioner of Correction, or their designees. The Chief
    - 10 State's Attorney shall serve as chairperson of the panel and shall
    - 11 coordinate the agencies responsible for the implementation and
    - 12 maintenance of the DNA data bank established pursuant to section 54-
    - 13 102j of the general statutes, as amended by this act.

14 (b) The panel shall take such action as necessary to assure the  
15 integrity of the data bank including the destruction of inappropriately  
16 obtained samples and the purging of all records and identifiable  
17 information pertaining to the persons from whom such  
18 inappropriately obtained samples were collected.

19 (c) The panel shall meet on a quarterly basis and shall maintain  
20 records of its meetings. Such records shall be retained by the  
21 chairperson."
