"AN ACT CONCERNING INDOOR TANNING."

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- 1 In line 3, strike "(A)"
- 2 In line 4, strike "(B)" and insert "any individual who," in lieu thereof
- 3 In line 15, after "or" insert "any"
- 4 Strike lines 16 to 21, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
- 5 following in lieu thereof:
- 6 "(b) Each tanning facility shall: (1) Post a sign readily visible to
- 7 persons entering such facility that includes warnings about risks
- 8 associated with use of a tanning device, instructions for use and notice
- 9 that consumer complaints may be directed to the Department of Public
- 10 Health; (2) require consumers, prior to use of any tanning device, to
- 11 read and sign a statement that includes warnings about failure to use
- 12 protective eyewear and health risks associated with the use of tanning
- 13 devices; and (3) instruct consumers on the use of protective eyewear.
- 14 Operators shall require consumers to wear protective eyewear when

15 using a tanning device, and, if necessary, may lend properly sanitized
16 protective eyewear for a consumer's use while in the facility. Signs and
17 statements required by this subsection shall be approved by the
18 municipal health department or health district for the municipality in
19 which the tanning facility is located.

20 (c) No operator shall allow an unemancipated minor under the age
21 of eighteen to use a tanning device without the written permission of
22 the parent or guardian of such minor on a form approved by the
23 municipal health department or health district for the municipality in
24 which the tanning facility is located. Such written permission shall be
25 signed on the premises at the minor's first visit, and shall expire ninety
26 days after the date it was signed.

27 (d) (1) Any operator who violates any provision of this section shall
28 be fined not more than one hundred dollars or imprisoned not more
29 than ninety days, or both. Any fine shall be payable to the municipal
30 health department or health district for the municipality in which the
31 tanning facility is located."
