"AN ACT CONCERNING INVESTIGATIVE SUBPOENAS."

1 Strike section 5 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 5. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) (a) Any subpoena issued
4 pursuant to sections 1 to 12, inclusive, of this act shall compel the
5 witness to appear and testify or produce the property in the presence
6 of a judge at a specified courtroom location in a courthouse in the
7 judicial district where the incident or incidents subject to investigation
8 are alleged to have occurred. No testimony shall be given or property
9 produced by the person summoned until counsel for such person is
10 present in the courtroom or, if such person is determined to be
11 indigent pursuant to section 51-296 of the general statutes, until a
12 public defender has been appointed for such person and such public
13 defender is present in the courtroom, and counsel has had an
14 opportunity to consult with such person and prepare for such

15 proceeding.

16 (b) Any person summoned to appear by subpoena issued pursuant
17 to sections 1 to 12, inclusive, of this act shall be entitled to
18 compensation for costs incurred in appearing including transportation,
19 lodging, parking, meals, child care and lost wages pursuant to the
20 general statutes. Such person shall be entitled to reimbursement for
21 reasonable attorney's fees unless such person is subsequently charged
22 and convicted of an offense as a result of the investigation for which
23 the subpoena was issued."
