"AN ACT CONCERNING INVESTIGATIVE SUBPOENAS."

1 Strike section 8 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 8. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2003) If any witness properly
4 summoned fails without valid reason to appear or to produce any
5 property specified in the subpoena or, if having appeared, fails to
6 answer any proper question, the prosecuting official may apply to a
7 judge of the Superior Court in the judicial district as provided in
8 section 5 of this act requesting the issuance of a capias or an order of
9 contempt, as appropriate, with respect to such witness. The application
10 of the prosecuting official and the order of the court shall be sealed as
11 to the public and not be subject to disclosure. The hearing on the
12 application shall not be open to the public."
