**"AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO CERTAIN DEPARTMENT
OF PUBLIC HEALTH STATUTES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective October 1, 2003*) Notwithstanding the provisions
4 of section 20-195c of the general statutes, during the period from
5 October 1, 2003, to October 31, 2003, inclusive, the Department of
6 Public Health shall issue a license to practice as a marital and family
7 therapist under chapter 383a of the general statutes to any applicant
8 who presents to the department satisfactory evidence that the
9 applicant: (1) Earned a masters degree in Guidance and Personnel
10 Services prior to 1992; (2) holds current clinical membership from the
11 American Association of Marital and Family Therapists originally
12 issued prior to 1992; and (3) has provided counseling services for not
13 less than ten years within the fifteen-year period immediately
14 preceding the date of application."
