"AN ACT CONCERNING INVESTIGATIVE SUBPOENAS."

1 Strike section 8 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 8. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) If any witness properly
4 summoned fails to appear or to produce any property specified in the
5 subpoena or, if having appeared, refuses to answer any proper
6 question, the prosecuting official may apply to a judge of the Superior
7 Court in the judicial district as provided in section 5 of this act
8 requesting the issuance of a *capias* or an order of contempt, as
9 appropriate, with respect to such witness. The application of the
10 prosecuting official and the order of the court shall be sealed as to the
11 public and not be subject to disclosure. The hearing on the application
12 shall not be open to the public."
