**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE'S CIVIL PREPAREDNESS FORCES AND REQUIRING AN EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLAN."**

1 Strike section 2 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Any paid or volunteer  
4 firefighter, police officer or emergency medical service personnel who  
5 successfully completes an approved training course in the use of auto-  
6 injectors provided by the Connecticut Fire Commission, the Capital  
7 Region Metropolitan Medical Response System or the federal  
8 government may carry and use nerve agent antidote medications in  
9 the event of a nerve agent exposure for self-preservation or unit  
10 preservation."
