**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE'S CIVIL PREPAREDNESS  
FORCES AND REQUIRING AN EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS  
PLAN."**

1 Strike section 2 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Any paid or volunteer  
4 firefighter, police officer or emergency medical service personnel who  
5 successfully completes a training course in the use of automatic  
6 prefilled cartridge injectors may carry and use such injectors  
7 containing nerve agent antidote medications in the event of a nerve  
8 agent exposure for self-preservation or unit preservation. Such training  
9 course shall be approved by the director of the Office of Emergency  
10 Management and provided by the Connecticut Fire Academy, the  
11 Capitol Region Metropolitan Medical Response System or the federal  
12 government."
