**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES."**

1 Strike section 501 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) (a) In the event the  
4 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles issues a motor vehicle operator's  
5 license in accordance with the provisions of section 14-36 of the general  
6 statutes or an identity card in accordance with the provisions of section  
7 1-1h of the general statutes to any person who is a resident of this state  
8 and not a citizen of the United States and whose presence in the United  
9 States is, pursuant to any provision of federal law, not of unlimited  
10 duration, the commissioner shall, unless such person presents  
11 evidence satisfactory to the commissioner that such person has a  
12 pending application for change or extension of his or her authorized

13 presence in the United States under federal law or is a beneficiary of  
14 Section 245 (i) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, restrict validity  
15 of such motor vehicle operator's license or identity card to a limited  
16 term to coincide with the period of such person's lawful presence in  
17 the United States. Any person who has been issued a motor vehicle  
18 operator's license or identity card under this subsection and has been  
19 granted an extension of stay or has obtained permanent resident status  
20 may request, and the commissioner shall, upon presentation of  
21 evidence satisfactory to the commissioner and surrender of the  
22 document that has been issued, issue to such person another motor  
23 vehicle operator's license or identity card bearing a new expiration  
24 date. The fee for any motor vehicle operator's license issued for a  
25 limited term shall be computed in accordance with section 14-41 of the  
26 general statutes. Any person aggrieved by any decision of the  
27 commissioner made pursuant to this subsection shall be afforded an  
28 opportunity for a hearing in accordance with the provisions of chapter  
29 54 of the general statutes.

30 (b) The commissioner shall adopt regulations, in accordance with  
31 chapter 54 of the general statutes, to implement the provisions of  
32 subsection (a) of this section. The regulations shall require the conduct  
33 of regular training sessions for the staff of the Department of Motor  
34 Vehicles with regard to the recognition and verification of documents  
35 evidencing employment authorization and lawful presence in the  
36 United States."
