**"AN ACT CONCERNING PROFESSIONAL BAIL BONDSMEN AND
BAIL ENFORCEMENT AGENTS."**

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 29-221 of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

5 As used in this chapter: (1) "Board" means the Examining Board for
6 Crane Operators established under section 29-222; (2) "commissioner"
7 means the Commissioner of Public Safety; (3) "crane" means (A) a
8 tower crane used in construction, demolition or excavation work, (B)
9 hydraulic cranes, (C) power-operated derricks, [or] (D) a mobile crane
10 which is a mobile, carrier-mounted, power-operated hoisting machine
11 utilizing a power-operated boom which moves laterally by rotation of
12 the machine on the carrier and which has a manufacturers' maximum
13 rated capacity exceeding five tons; (4) "hoisting equipment" means

14 motorized equipment (A) used in construction, demolition or
15 excavation work, (B) at a construction site for a project, other than a
16 project involving residential structures of less than four stories, the
17 estimated cost of which is more than one million two hundred fifty
18 thousand dollars, and (C) which has a manufacturer's rated lifting
19 capacity exceeding five tons and a manufacturer's rated maximum
20 reach in excess of thirty-five feet; (5) "department" means the
21 Department of Public Safety; and [(5)] (6) "apprentice" means anyone
22 registered with the board for the purpose of learning crane operation
23 or hoisting equipment operation. "
