**"AN ACT CONCERNING A FIREARM BALLISTIC IDENTIFICATION
DATA BANK."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 29-28a of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

5 (a) Requests for temporary state permits under section 29-28 shall be
6 submitted to the chief of police, or, where there is no chief of police, to
7 the warden of the borough or the first selectman of the town, as the
8 case may be, on application forms prescribed by the Commissioner of
9 Public Safety. Upon written request by any person for a temporary
10 state permit not on a prescribed application form, or upon request by
11 any person for such application form, the local authority shall supply
12 such forms. When any such request is made in person at the office of
13 the local authority, the local authority shall supply such application
14 form immediately. When any such request is made in any other

15 manner, the local authority shall supply such application form not
16 later than one week after receiving such request. If such application
17 form is not supplied within the time limits required by this section, the
18 request therefor shall constitute a sufficient application. If any local
19 authority fails to supply an application form upon the request of any
20 person, such person may request an application form from the
21 Commissioner of Public Safety or any barracks of the Division of State
22 Police, and the time limits and procedures set forth in this section for
23 handling requests for such forms shall be applicable.

24 (b) Any person submitting an application pursuant to subsection (a)
25 of this section shall submit (1) the application form prescribed by the
26 Commissioner of Public Safety, which form shall be signed and
27 notarized and shall not be modified or supplemented with additional
28 forms or requirements, (2) with respect to citizens of the United States,
29 a birth certificate, naturalization certificate or valid United States
30 passport or, with respect to legal aliens, a permanent resident card, (3)
31 a certificate of successful completion of a safety or training course in
32 the use of pistols or revolvers that satisfies the requirements of
33 subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of section 29-28, signed by the
34 instructor of such course, and (4) two sets of fingerprints.

35 [(b)] (c) The local authority shall, not later than eight weeks after a
36 sufficient application for a temporary state permit has been made,
37 inform the applicant that such applicant's request for a temporary state
38 permit has been approved or denied. The local authority shall forward
39 a copy of the application indicating approval or denial of the
40 temporary state permit to the Commissioner of Public Safety. If the
41 local authority has denied the application for a temporary state permit,
42 no state permit may be issued. The commissioner shall, not later than
43 eight weeks after receiving an application indicating approval from the
44 local authority, inform the applicant in writing that the applicant's
45 application for a state permit has been approved or denied, or that the
46 results of the national criminal history records check have not been
47 received. If grounds for denial become known after a temporary state
48 permit has been obtained, the temporary state permit shall be

49 immediately revoked pursuant to section 29-32."
