"AN ACT CONCERNING STATE EMPLOYEE CONTRACTS."

1 Strike subsection (c) of section 1 and insert in lieu thereof the
2 following:

3 "(c) The Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management shall,
4 within seven days of the effective date of this section, offer the
5 following contractual terms and conditions to all collective bargaining
6 units: (1) There shall be no general wage increase or annual increment
7 in fiscal year 2004; (2) those units which have not yet accepted a wage
8 freeze, and have settled wages for fiscal year 2004, but have not settled
9 wages for fiscal year 2005, shall receive the following offer: The fiscal
10 year 2005 wage increase shall be the amount currently scheduled for
11 fiscal year 2004; (3) those units which have not yet accepted a wage
12 freeze, and with settled wages for fiscal years 2004 and 2005, but not
13 2006, shall receive the following offer: (A) The fiscal year 2005 wage
14 increase shall be the amount currently scheduled for fiscal year 2004;
15 (B) the fiscal year 2006 raise shall be the amount currently scheduled
16 for fiscal year 2005; (4) those units which have not yet accepted a wage

17 freeze, and with settled wages for fiscal years 2004, 2005 and 2006,
18 shall receive the following offer: (A) The fiscal year 2005 wage increase
19 shall be the amount currently scheduled for fiscal year 2004; (B) the
20 fiscal year 2006 raise shall be the amount currently scheduled for fiscal
21 year 2005; (C) the fiscal year 2007 raise shall be the amount currently
22 scheduled for fiscal year 2006; (5) unless otherwise provided for in this
23 subsection, increment-based units shall receive annual increments at
24 the usual time; (6) any unit with a scheduled fiscal year 2004 increase
25 which has taken effect when the offer required by this section is
26 transmitted may choose to retain such increase, while otherwise
27 accepting this offer, except as modified by subdivision (7) of this
28 subsection; (7) any unit retaining a fiscal year 2004 increase under
29 subdivision (6) of this subsection shall forfeit the comparable increase
30 that otherwise would have occurred in fiscal year 2005; (8) any
31 arbitration award pending before the General Assembly as of the time
32 an offer is made pursuant to this section, shall be deemed to be a
33 settled contract for purposes of this section only; (9) there shall be no
34 layoffs in fiscal year 2004 or fiscal year 2005 unless specifically
35 identified in the biennial budget act as originally enacted for said fiscal
36 years; (10) there shall be no layoffs in fiscal year 2006 or fiscal year
37 2007."
