**"AN ACT CONCERNING GENERAL BUDGET AND REVENUE
IMPLEMENTATION PROVISIONS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Any contract or renewal of any
4 contract with any governmental or private vendor for the supervision
5 of inmates outside the state entered into by the Commissioner of
6 Correction pursuant to section 18-86b of the general statutes, as
7 amended by this act, on or after the effective date of this section, shall
8 provide that (1) the failure of the vendor to notify the commissioner as
9 soon as possible, but not later than one working day, after an escape of
10 an inmate shall constitute a material breach of the contract, (2) the
11 vendor shall indemnify the state for financial loss and expense arising
12 out of any claim, demand, suit or judgment by any person who suffers
13 injury to person or property resulting from the actions of any such
14 escaped inmate, and (3) the vendor shall indemnify the state for any
15 costs it incurs in apprehending and prosecuting any such escaped
16 inmate."
