Substitute House Bill No. 5584

*House of Representatives, April 5, 2004*

The Committee on Education reported through REP. GIANNAROS of the 21st Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

## **AN ACT CONCERNING THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH COMPLIANCE WITH THE NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND ACT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Secretary of the Office of Policy  
2 and Management and the Commissioner of Education, or their  
3 designees, shall analyze the costs associated with compliance with  
4 mandates imposed by the No Child Left Behind Act, P.L. 107-110. Such  
5 analysis shall include an estimate of the costs to the state and local and  
6 regional boards of education for such compliance, with appropriated  
7 federal funds for such compliance deducted from the cost. The  
8 secretary and the commissioner, or their designees, shall, on or before  
9 January 1, 2005, report their findings, pursuant to the provisions of  
10 section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of  
11 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to  
12 education.

Neither the budget of the State Department of Education nor the Office of Policy and Management contains funds for this purpose.
