House Bill No. 5679

*House of Representatives, April 13, 2004*

The Committee on Appropriations reported through REP. DYSON of the 94th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

***AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2004*) The Board of Governors of  
2 Higher Education shall review the programs and services  
3 administered or provided by the Department of Higher Education in  
4 order to assess the effectiveness and the benefits of such programs and  
5 services and assign priority for their continued funding. The board  
6 shall submit its findings and recommendations to the joint standing  
7 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters  
8 relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not later  
9 than January 1, 2005, and annually thereafter.

This act shall take effect as follows:
