AN ACT CONCERNING THE POWER OF THE GRADUATE INSTITUTE TO CONFER DEGREES AND GRANT DIPLOMAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Graduate Institute, located in
2 the towns of Milford and New London, shall have power, in
3 accordance with its bylaws and subject to such requirements as may be
4 prescribed for institutions of higher learning by the Board of
5 Governors for Higher Education, as provided in section 10a-34 of the
6 general statutes, to confer such degrees and grant such diplomas as are
7 customary in institutions of higher learning.
