The resolution accepts the Claims Commissioner’s recommendation to deny awards and permission to sue in 64 claims against the state, each of which is in excess of \$7,500. The resolution thereby results in the avoidance of a potential, significant state cost for any judgments that might have been rendered against it. The aggregate amount claimed is approximately \$23.6 million.
