*Senate, March 29, 2004*

The Committee on Planning and Development reported through SEN. FONFARA of the 1st Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

## **AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO REGIONAL PLANNING ORGANIZATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2004*) The sum of six hundred forty  
2 thousand dollars is appropriated to the Office of Policy and  
3 Management, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June  
4 30, 2005, for grants to regional planning agencies under section 4-124q  
5 of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows:
