#### **Explanation**

The resolution permits certain employees of the Department of Revenue Services to receive overtime pay for participating in the motor fuel highway enforcement program. There will be no cost to the state as a result of the resolution since the payment of overtime compensation will be paid from a federal department of transportation grant. The state received a federal grant of \$20,000 for the purpose of payment of overtime expenses incurred as a result of motor fuel highway enforcement. Therefore the resolution stipulates that overtime payments will not exceed \$20,000.
