AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STUDY OF THE LENGTH OF THE ADOPTION PROCESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 5,
2 2005, the Commissioner of Children and Families shall report, in
3 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
4 to the select committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
5 matters relating to children, on the feasibility of reducing the time
6 period for an adoption to two years or less.

This act shall take effect as follows:
