**AN ACT CONCERNING CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY FOR THE CHILD CARE SUBSIDY PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (f) of section 17b-749 of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
3 *October 1, 2004*):

4 (f) [On or after January 1, 1998, the] The commissioner shall adopt  
5 regulations, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 54, to  
6 implement the provisions of this section. Such regulations shall include  
7 that any person receiving benefits under the child care subsidy  
8 program shall, in the event the commissioner determines that such  
9 person is no longer eligible to receive benefits under the program, be  
10 provided with written notice stating in plain language the factual basis  
11 for such determination and providing an opportunity for a hearing in  
12 accordance with the provision of chapter 54 prior to the termination of  
13 such person's benefits under said program.

This act shall take effect as follows:

Section 1	October 1, 2004
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**Statement of Purpose:**

To require the Commissioner of Social Services to provide written notice to child care subsidy recipients prior to the termination of benefits.
