**Substitute Bill No. 5510**

**AN ACT CONCERNING PAYMENTS TO VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES FOR CALLS ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2004*) The State Fire Administrator  
2 shall pay to each volunteer fire company for each call to which it  
3 responds on any limited access highway, or on that section of the  
4 highway known as the Berlin Turnpike, which begins at the end of the  
5 existing Wilbur Cross Parkway in the town of Meriden and extends  
6 northerly along Route 15 to the beginning of that section of limited  
7 access highway in the town of Wethersfield known as the Wilbur  
8 Cross Parkway and the South Meadows Expressway, or on that section  
9 of Route 8 in Beacon Falls which is within the boundaries of the  
10 Naugatuck State Forest, the sum of one hundred dollars; provided, in  
11 relation to the Berlin Turnpike as described in this section, such sum  
12 shall be payable only in respect to fires involving motor vehicles using  
13 the turnpike. Said administrator may designate a volunteer fire  
14 company to be responsible for the extinguishing of fires on any portion  
15 of such highways for which no fire protection is otherwise provided,  
16 and in each such case said administrator shall pay to such company  
17 one hundred dollars per year in addition to the one-hundred-dollar fee  
18 provided for in this section.

This act shall take effect as follows:
