**AN ACT CONCERNING PROPERTY TAXES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Office of Policy and  
2 Management shall study the feasibility of eliminating the personal  
3 property tax on motor vehicles and the resulting effect on taxpayers in  
4 this state and shall determine any costs or benefits of such action. On  
5 or before February 1, 2005, the Secretary of the Office of Policy and  
6 Management shall report to the joint standing committee of the  
7 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to finance,  
8 revenue and bonding, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-  
9 4a of the general statutes, as to any finding or recommendations  
10 regarding the elimination of the tax.

This act shall take effect as follows:
