**RESOLUTION CONTINUING THE SELECT COMMITTEE OF INQUIRY
TO RECOMMEND WHETHER SUFFICIENT GROUNDS EXIST FOR
THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO IMPEACH GOVERNOR
JOHN G. ROWLAND PURSUANT TO ARTICLE NINTH OF THE STATE
CONSTITUTION.**

Resolved by this House:

1 WHEREAS, the Select Committee of Inquiry to Recommend
2 Whether Sufficient Grounds Exist for the House of Representatives to
3 Impeach Governor John G. Rowland Pursuant to Article Ninth of the
4 State Constitution created by House Resolution 702 is continuing its
5 investigation; and

6 WHEREAS, it appears that the investigation of facts, the extensive
7 testimony to be heard, and the findings to be reviewed by the
8 committee will preclude completion of its work prior to May 5, 2004,
9 the adjournment date of the 2004 regular session of the General
10 Assembly.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Select Committee

12 of Inquiry, as created by House Resolution 702 and as constituted by
13 the Speaker of the House of Representatives, shall continue in
14 existence after the adjournment sine die of the 2004 regular session,
15 and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Select Committee of Inquiry
17 is authorized to recommend a resolution to the House of
18 Representatives and that any report, including any recommended
19 resolution, submitted by said Committee in accordance with section
20 five of House Resolution 702 shall be submitted to the clerk of the
21 House.
