**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT'S RESIDENT COORDINATOR  
PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2004*) Any resident service  
2 coordinator, as described in section 8-114d of the general statutes,  
3 employed by a housing authority, municipal developer or nonprofit  
4 corporation shall be responsible for, but not be limited to, the  
5 following duties: (1) Providing intervention services to residents of  
6 such elderly housing project in the form of dispute and conflict  
7 resolution between elderly residents and persons with mental  
8 disabilities who reside in such housing projects; (2) assessing the  
9 individual needs of residents of such housing for the purpose of  
10 establishing and maintaining support services; (3) maintaining regular  
11 contact with residents of such housing; (4) monitoring the delivery of  
12 support services to residents of such housing; and (5) advocating  
13 changes in services sought or required by residents of such housing.

14 Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2004*) The sum of five hundred thousand  
15 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Economic and

16 Community Development, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year  
17 ending June 30, 2005, for the purpose of funding grants-in-aid to  
18 housing authorities, municipal developers and nonprofit corporations  
19 operating elderly housing projects to hire resident service coordinators  
20 responsible for providing mediation and conflict resolution services for  
21 residents of such elderly housing projects.

This act shall take effect as follows:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To increase funding for the resident service coordinator program in order to provide greater conflict resolution services to the elderly residing in elderly housing projects.
