**AN ACT PROVIDING FREE TUITION AT STATE COLLEGES AND
UNIVERSITIES FOR CHILDREN AND SPOUSES OF MILITARY
PERSONNEL KILLED IN ACTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 185b of the general statutes be amended to waive the
- 2 payment of tuition fees at the Connecticut State University system, The
- 3 University of Connecticut and the regional community-technical
- 4 colleges for any dependent child or spouse of any person who served
- 5 in the armed forces in time of war and who was killed in action or who
- 6 died as a result of accident or illness sustained while performing active
- 7 military duty with the armed forces of the United States.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide free tuition for any dependent child or spouse of any
person who served in the armed forces in time of war and was killed in
action or who died due to an accident or illness sustained while
performing active military duty.
