**AN ACT CONCERNING THE MONITORING OF METAL DETECTORS
AT CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Correction
2 shall ensure that at least one female correction officer is assigned to
3 monitor female visitors who are required to walk through a metal
4 detector in order to enter a correctional institution. For purposes of this
5 section, "correctional institution" means the facilities defined in section
6 1-1 of the general statutes and any other correctional facility
7 established by the Commissioner of Correction.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that female correction officers are available to monitor female visitors who are required to walk through a metal detector in order to enter a correctional institution.
