AN ACT ESTABLISHING A FREDERICK LAW OLMSTED DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 10-29a of the general statutes, as amended by
2 section 1 of public act 03-29 and section 1 of public act 03-79, is
3 amended by adding subdivision (49) as follows (*Effective October 1,*
4 *2004*):

5 (NEW) (49) The Governor shall proclaim April twenty-sixth of each
6 year to be "Frederick Law Olmsted Day" to honor his legacy as the
7 founder of American landscape architecture. Suitable exercises shall be
8 held in the State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for
9 the observance of the day.

This act shall take effect as follows:
