**"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE  
LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM REVIEW AND INVESTIGATIONS  
COMMITTEE CONCERNING CORRECTION OFFICER STAFFING."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a  
4 Commission on Government Accountability, Creativity and Efficiency  
5 that shall consist of the following twenty-nine members: (1) The  
6 chairpersons and ranking members of the Legislative Program Review  
7 and Investigations Committee and the joint standing committee on  
8 Appropriations; (2) three appointed by the speaker of the House of  
9 Representatives; (3) three appointed by the president pro tempore of  
10 the Senate; (4) three appointed by the majority leader of the House of  
11 Representatives; (5) three appointed by the majority leader of the  
12 Senate; (6) three appointed by the minority leader of the House of  
13 Representatives; (7) three appointed by the minority leader of the  
14 Senate; and (8) three appointed by the Governor. Any member of the  
15 commission appointed pursuant to subdivisions (2) to (7), inclusive, of

16 this subsection may be a member of the General Assembly. All  
17 appointments to the commission shall be made on or before June 11,  
18 2004. The members of the commission shall elect a chairperson.

19 (b) The commission shall review the report of the Task Force on  
20 Accountability, Creativity and Efficiency, and determine which areas  
21 recommended for further study within such report need to be  
22 reviewed and conduct such reviews.

23 (c) The commission shall begin its review not later than June 11,  
24 2004, and, on or before January 5, 2005, shall submit a report on its  
25 findings and recommendations to the Governor and the joint standing  
26 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters  
27 relating to such findings and recommendations, in accordance with the  
28 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes. The task force shall  
29 terminate on the date that it submits such report or January 5, 2005,  
30 whichever is earlier."
