1 In line 1466, strike "8-358,"

2 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
3 internal references accordingly:

4 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 8-358 of the general statutes, as
5 amended by section 97 of public act 03-3 of the June 30 special session,
6 is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
7 *October 1, 2004*):

8 [(a) If a person residing in a dwelling unit in any project receiving
9 financial assistance pursuant to sections 8-355 to 8-359, inclusive, is a
10 recipient of general assistance as a one person household under
11 sections 17b-118, 17b-118a, 17b-118b, 17b-119, 17b-122, 17b-124 to 17b-
12 132, inclusive, 17b-136 to 17b-138, inclusive, 17b-221 to 17b-250,
13 inclusive, 17b-256, 17b-263, 17b-340 to 17b-350, inclusive, 17b-689, 17b-

14 689b and 17b-743 to 17b-747, inclusive, the rental payment for such
15 person's dwelling unit shall be an amount equal to the shelter
16 component of the general assistance grant as determined by the town
17 in accordance with regulations adopted by the Commissioner of Social
18 Services pursuant to section 17b-78. Otherwise, the]

19 (a) The maximum amount which a person or family residing in a
20 dwelling unit in a project receiving financial assistance under sections
21 8-355 to 8-359, inclusive, shall pay as its contribution to the total rent
22 for the dwelling unit shall be thirty per cent of the adjusted monthly
23 income, as defined by the commissioner pursuant to subsection (b) of
24 this section, of the household in which the person resides or of the
25 family, less the amount of such household's or family's utility
26 allowance."
