**"AN ACT MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 2005, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR, MAKING DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2004, AND MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO STATE AND MUNICIPAL REVENUES."**

1 In line T1137, strike "72, 972, 175" and insert "75, 972, 175" in lieu  
2 thereof

3 Adjust agency, function and fund totals accordingly

4 Strike section 10 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

5 "Sec. 10. (*Effective from passage*) Prior to June 30, 2004, the  
6 Comptroller shall transfer \$125,300,000 of fiscal year 2004 General  
7 Fund revenue for use as General Fund revenue for fiscal year 2005.  
8 Prior to the close of the accounts for the General Fund for fiscal year  
9 2004, if the Comptroller finds a deficit exists in the General Fund for  
10 fiscal year 2004, the amount of the appropriation in section 48 of this  
11 act to the Department of Higher Education, for Higher Education State

12 Matching Grant, shall be reduced by the amount necessary to prevent  
13 such a deficit."

14 In line 341, after "be", insert "deposited into the Budget Reserve  
15 Fund established in section 4-30a of the general statutes." and strike  
16 "utilized to reduce"

17 Strike lines 342 to 344, inclusive, in their entirety

18 In line 468, strike "[and on and after July 1, 2004," and insert in lieu  
19 thereof "and on and after July 1, [2004,] 2005,"

20 In line 471, strike the closing bracket

21 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
22 internal references accordingly:

23 "Sec. 501. Section 17a-451d of the general statutes is repealed and the  
24 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

25 There is established a nonlapsing fund that shall contain (1) any  
26 moneys received by the state from the sale, lease or transfer of all or  
27 any part of [Fairfield Hills Hospital,] Norwich Hospital or any regional  
28 center that takes place after January 1, 2001, and (2) any other moneys  
29 required by law to be deposited in a separate account within the  
30 General Fund for purposes of this section, section 17a-212a or 17a-283a  
31 or section 4 of public act 01-154\*. The Treasurer shall credit the fund  
32 with its investment earnings. Any balance remaining in said fund at  
33 the end of any fiscal year shall be carried forward in the fund for the  
34 fiscal year next succeeding. The principal and interest of the fund shall  
35 be used solely for the purpose of site acquisition, capital development  
36 and infrastructure costs necessary to provide services to persons with  
37 mental retardation or psychiatric disabilities, provided amounts in the  
38 fund may be expended only pursuant to appropriation by the General  
39 Assembly.

40 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) Any moneys received by the state  
41 from the sale, lease or transfer of all or any part of Fairfield Hills

42 Hospital shall be allocated to the Department of Mental Health and  
43 Addiction Services and shall be divided equally between the General  
44 Fund accounts for the Community Mental Health Strategy Board and  
45 Grants for Mental Health Services."
