"AN ACT MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 2005, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR, MAKING DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2004, AND MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO STATE AND MUNICIPAL REVENUES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
4 sections 3-55i to 3-55k, inclusive, of the general statutes, or of any
5 public or special act, no municipality shall receive more than
6 \$5,000,000 from the Mashantucket Pequot and Mohegan Fund during
7 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005. Any amounts which any
8 municipality would be otherwise entitled to receive from said fund
9 which exceed \$5,000,000 shall be distributed to municipalities
10 receiving \$5,000,000 or less from said fund during said fiscal year in
11 accordance with the provisions of sections 13a-175a to 13a-175j,

12 inclusive, of the general statutes, concerning Town Aid Road funding."
