**"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE GOVERNOR'S BUDGET
RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING REVENUE, TOBACCO
PRODUCT MANUFACTURERS AND TRANSFERS OF CERTAIN
FUNDS."**

1 Strike sections 1 to 6, inclusive, 19 and 20 in their entirety and
2 renumber the remaining sections and internal references accordingly

3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
4 internal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2004, and applicable to sales occurring
6 on or after July 1, 2004) From the third Sunday in August until the

7 Saturday next succeeding, inclusive, the provisions of chapter 219 of
8 the general statutes shall not apply to sales of any article of clothing or
9 footwear intended to be worn on or about the human body the cost of
10 which article to the purchaser is less than three hundred dollars. For
11 purposes of this section, clothing or footwear shall not include (1) any
12 special clothing or footwear primarily designed for athletic activity or
13 protective use and which is not normally worn except when used for
14 the athletic activity or protective use for which it was designed, and (2)
15 jewelry, handbags, luggage, umbrellas, wallets, watches and similar
16 items carried on or about the human body but not worn on the body in
17 the manner characteristic of clothing intended for exemption under
18 this section."
