**"AN ACT CONCERNING CLEAN CARS."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 22a-174g of the general statutes, as amended by  
4 section 10 of public act 03-218, is repealed and the following is  
5 substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2004*)

6 (a) On or before December 31, 2004, the Commissioner of  
7 Environmental Protection shall adopt regulations, in accordance with  
8 the provisions of chapter 54, to implement the light duty motor vehicle  
9 emission standards of the state of California, and shall amend such  
10 regulations from time to time, in accordance with changes in said  
11 standards. Such regulations shall be applicable to motor vehicles with  
12 a model year 2008 and later. Such regulations may incorporate by  
13 reference the California motor vehicle emission standards set forth in  
14 final regulations issued by the California Air Resources Board  
15 pursuant to Title 13 of the California Code of Regulations and

16 promulgated under the authority of Division 26 of the California  
 17 Health and Safety Code, as may be amended from time to time.  
 18 Nothing in this section shall limit the commissioner's authority to  
 19 regulate motor vehicle emissions for any other class of vehicle.

20 (b) As part of the state's implementation plan under the federal  
 21 Clean Air Act, the Commissioner of Environmental Protection may  
 22 establish a program to allow the sale, purchase and use of motor  
 23 vehicles which comply with any regulations adopted by the  
 24 commissioner which implement the California motor vehicles  
 25 emissions standards for purposes of generating any emission  
 26 reduction credits under said act. Nothing in this section shall prohibit  
 27 the Commissioner of Environmental Protection from establishing a  
 28 program to require the sale, purchase and use of motor vehicles which  
 29 comply with any regulations adopted by the commissioner which  
 30 implement the California motor vehicle emissions standards. [Such  
 31 regulations may incorporate by reference the California motor vehicle  
 32 emission standards set forth in final regulations issued by the  
 33 California Air Resources Board pursuant to Title 13 of the California  
 34 Code of Regulations and promulgated under the authority of Division  
 35 26 of the California Health and Safety Code, as may be amended from  
 36 time to time.]"

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2004</i>
