**"AN ACT CONCERNING HOME HEATING OIL DEALERS."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. Section 20-417aa of the general statutes, as amended by  
4      section 146 of public act 03-6 of the June 30 special session, is repealed  
5      and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1,*  
6      *2004*):

7      (a) As used in this section, "swimming pool maintenance and repair  
8      work" means the performance of all plumbing, heating and electrical  
9      work necessary to service, modify or repair any swimming pool, hot  
10     tub, spa or similar recreational or therapeutic equipment, where such  
11     work commences at an outlet, receptacle, connection, back-flow  
12     preventor or fuel supply pipe previously installed by a person holding  
13     the proper license, "portable hot tub or spa" means a nonpermanent  
14     structure intended for recreational bathing, in which all controls,  
15     water-heating and water-circulating equipment are an integral part of

16 the product and "portable hot tub or spa maintenance and repair  
17 work" means the performance of all plumbing, heating and electrical  
18 work necessary to service, modify or repair and portable hot tub or  
19 spa, where such work commences at an outlet, receptacle, connection,  
20 back-low preventor or fuel supply pipe properly installed by a person  
21 holding the proper license.

22 (b) On or after July 1, 2000, the following limited licenses for  
23 swimming pool maintenance and repair work may be issued by the  
24 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Protection upon  
25 authorization of the Plumbing and Piping Work Board established  
26 under the provisions of section 20-331, as amended: A limited  
27 swimming pool maintenance and repair contractor's license, [and] a  
28 limited swimming pool maintenance and repair journeyman's license  
29 and a portable hot tub or spa maintenance and repair contractor's  
30 license.

31 (c) The Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Protection,  
32 with the advice and assistance of the Plumbing and Piping Work  
33 Board, shall adopt regulations in accordance with the provisions of  
34 chapter 54 to implement the provisions of this section, including  
35 establishing the amount and type of experience and training required  
36 to qualify an applicant for an examination for any limited license for  
37 swimming pool maintenance and repair work or portable hot tub or  
38 spa maintenance and repair work.

39 (d) Any person engaged in swimming pool maintenance and repair  
40 work prior to July 1, 1999, may apply to the Department of Agriculture  
41 and Consumer Protection for the appropriate limited license and such  
42 license shall be issued without examination upon demonstration by  
43 the applicant of experience and training equivalent to the experience  
44 and training required to qualify for examination for the appropriate  
45 limited license, if such applicant makes such application to the  
46 department not later than January 1, 2002."
