"AN ACT CONCERNING SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM REVISIONS."

1 Strike section 2 and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 2. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding section 10-16l of the
3 general statutes, for the school year ending June 30, 2004, any local or
4 regional board of education that, prior to May 1, 2004, scheduled a
5 graduation date for students in grade twelve and has been forced to
6 close a high school building for emergency repairs, may hold a
7 graduation ceremony on the scheduled date, provided such high
8 school continues to provide for at least one hundred eighty days and
9 nine hundred hours of actual school work for such school year."
