**"AN ACT PROTECTING HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS OF  
RETIRED MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective October 1, 2004*) (NEW) Not sooner than four  
4 years after leaving state office or leaving employment, whichever is  
5 later, any person vested in the state employees retirement system who  
6 has completed at least six years of consecutive service as a member of  
7 the General Assembly may purchase credit, if a member of Tier I or  
8 Tier IIA, or receive credit, if a member of Tier II, for each year of  
9 service as a paid municipal chief executive officer, as set forth in  
10 subsection (a) of section 7-193 of the general statutes. A member of Tier  
11 I or Tier IIA shall receive such credit by making contributions to the  
12 State Employees Retirement Fund, for each year of such prior  
13 municipal service, equal to five per cent of such member's annual  
14 municipal salary, plus interest at the rate of five per cent thereon from  
15 the date of such municipal service to the date of payment."

This act shall take effect as follows:
