**"AN ACT PROTECTING HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS OF
RETIRED MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (f) of section 51-295a of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2004*):

6 (f) For purposes of determining the retirement salary of each Chief
7 Public Defender, Deputy Chief Public Defender or public defender
8 under subsection (b) of this section and the allowance payable to their
9 surviving spouses under subsection (e) of this section, "salary of the
10 office" shall be composed of the total of the following amounts: The
11 annual salary of the office which [he] such person held at the time of
12 [his] retirement, as such salary may be changed from time to time and
13 for each Chief Public Defender, Deputy Chief Public Defender and
14 public defender to whom a longevity payment has been made or is

15 due and payable, in each instance under section 51-295b or section 5-
16 213, (1) one and one-half per cent of annual salary, as such salary may
17 change from time to time, for those who have completed ten or more
18 but less than fifteen years of service as a Chief Public Defender,
19 Deputy Chief Public Defender, [or] public defender or assistant public
20 defender, (2) three per cent of annual salary, as such salary may
21 change from time to time, for those who have completed fifteen or
22 more but less than twenty years of service as Chief Public Defender,
23 Deputy Chief Public Defender, [or] public defender or assistant public
24 defender, (3) four and one-half per cent of annual salary, as such salary
25 may change from time to time, for those who have completed twenty
26 or more but less than twenty-five years of service as a Chief Public
27 Defender, Deputy Chief Public Defender, [or] public defender or
28 assistant public defender, and (4) six per cent of annual salary, as such
29 salary may change from time to time, for those who have completed
30 twenty-five or more years of service as a Chief Public Defender,
31 Deputy Chief Public Defender, [or] public defender or assistant public
32 defender."
