10 submit the proposed regulations on or before such date and shall  
11 include in such notice (1) the reasons why the department will not  
12 submit the proposed regulations by such date, and (2) the date by

13 which the department will submit the proposed regulations. The  
14 legislative regulation review committee may require"

17 lieu thereof: "The legislative regulation review committee may request  
18 the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having  
19 cognizance of matters relating to human services to review the  
20 department's policy, the department's reasons for not submitting the  
21 proposed regulations by the date specified in subsection (c) of this  
22 section and the date by which the department will submit the  
23 proposed regulations. Said joint standing committee may review the  
24 policy, such reasons and such date, may schedule a hearing thereon  
25 and may make a recommendation to the legislative regulation review  
26 committee."
