**"AN ACT CONCERNING AN AUTHORIZATION OF BONDS OF THE STATE FOR HIGHER EDUCATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND OTHER PURPOSES."**

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- 1 In line 80, strike the semi-colon and insert a period in lieu thereof
- 2 Strike lines 81 to 86, inclusive
- 3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
- 4 internal references accordingly:
- 5 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (5) of subsection (n) of section 2 of special act
- 6 95-20 is amended to read as follows (*Effective from passage*):
- 7 (5) Gateway Community-Technical College, New Haven: [Planning
- 8 for the development of additional parking] Implementation of the
- 9 master plan consolidating both campuses into a single location,
- 10 including legal and administrative fees associated with site acquisition,
- 11 demolition, design and site improvements, not exceeding \$350,000.

12 Sec. 502. Subdivision (5) of subsection (j) of section 21 of public act  
13 99-242 is amended to read as follows (*Effective from passage*):

14 (5) At Gateway Community-Technical College: [Alterations and  
15 improvements to buildings and grounds in accordance with the  
16 campus master plan] Implementation of the master plan consolidating  
17 both campuses into a single location, including legal and  
18 administrative fees associated with site acquisition, demolition, design  
19 and site improvements, not exceeding \$2,880,000.

20 Sec. 503. Subdivision (5) of subsection (i) of section 2 of special act  
21 01-2 of the June special session is amended to read as follows (*Effective*  
22 *from passage*):

23 (5) At Gateway Community-Technical College: [Development of  
24 facilities, including parking for the consolidation of college programs  
25 in one location] Implementation of the master plan consolidating both  
26 campuses into a single location, including legal and administrative fees  
27 associated with site acquisition, demolition, design and site  
28 improvements, not exceeding \$3,885,000."
