**"AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN REFORMS UNDER THE STATE
CODES OF ETHICS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2004*) The State Ethics Commission
4 shall develop and provide an orientation for each person nominated to
5 a position requiring the approval of one or both houses of the General
6 Assembly. Such orientation shall cover the requirements, prohibited
7 activities and enforcement of the code of ethics for public officials set
8 forth in part I of chapter 10 of the general statutes. Before confirmation
9 of each such person's nomination by the General Assembly, the person
10 shall sign a statement indicating that the person has attended such
11 orientation and understands the information contained in the
12 orientation as it applies to the position for which the person has been
13 nominated."
