"AN ACT CONCERNING NEW HOME CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTORS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 20-417aa of the general statutes, as amended by
4 section 146 of public act 03-6 of the June 30 special session, is repealed
5 and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1,*
6 *2004*):

7 (a) As used in this section, "swimming pool maintenance and repair
8 work" means the performance of all plumbing, heating and electrical
9 work necessary to service, modify or repair any swimming pool, hot
10 tub, spa or similar recreational or therapeutic equipment, where such
11 work commences at an outlet, receptacle, connection, back-flow
12 preventor or fuel supply pipe previously installed by a person holding
13 the proper license and "hot tub or spa maintenance and repair work"
14 means the performance of all plumbing, heating and electrical work
15 necessary to service, modify or repair any hot tub or spa, where such

16 work commences at an outlet, receptacle, connection, back-flow
17 preventor or fuel supply pipe previously installed by a person holding
18 the proper license.

19 (b) On or after July 1, 2000, the following limited licenses for
20 swimming pool maintenance and repair work may be issued by the
21 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Protection upon
22 authorization of the Plumbing and Piping Work Board established
23 under the provisions of section 20-331, as amended: A limited
24 swimming pool maintenance and repair contractor's license and a
25 limited swimming pool maintenance and repair journeyman's license.

26 (c) The Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Protection,
27 with the advice and assistance of the Plumbing and Piping Work
28 Board, shall adopt regulations, in accordance with the provisions of
29 chapter 54, to implement the provisions of this section, including
30 establishing the amount and type of experience and training required
31 to qualify an applicant for an examination for any limited license for
32 swimming pool maintenance and repair work or hot tub or spa
33 maintenance and repair work.

34 (d) Any person engaged in swimming pool maintenance and repair
35 work prior to July 1, 1999, may apply to the Department of Agriculture
36 and Consumer Protection for the appropriate limited license and such
37 license shall be issued without examination upon demonstration by
38 the applicant of experience and training equivalent to the experience
39 and training required to qualify for examination for the appropriate
40 limited license, if such applicant makes such application to the
41 department not later than January 1, 2002."
