"AN ACT PERMITTING STEM CELL RESEARCH AND BANNING HUMAN CLONING."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2004*) (a) For purposes of this
4 section, "cloning of a human being" means the replication of a human
5 individual by cultivating a cell with genetic material through the egg,
6 embryo, fetal or newborn stages into a new human individual.

7 (b) No person shall knowingly engage or assist, directly or
8 indirectly, in the cloning of a human being. Any person who violates
9 the provisions of this subsection shall be fined not more than fifty
10 thousand dollars or be imprisoned not more than ten years, or both.

11 (c) The Commissioner of Public Health shall enforce the provisions
12 of this section and may adopt regulations, in accordance with the
13 provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes, relating to the
14 administration and enforcement of this section. The commissioner may

15 request the Attorney General to petition the Superior Court for such
16 order as may be appropriate to enforce the provisions of this section."
