"AN ACT CONCERNING REGISTERED AGENTS AND ANNUAL REPORTS OF STOCK AND NONSTOCK CORPORATIONS, THE NAMES OF BUSINESS ENTITIES REQUIRED TO FILE WITH THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE, THE FILING OF AIRCRAFT AND VESSEL LIENS, THE FILING OF CERTAIN NOTICES AND REPORTS BY LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES AND JURISDICTION OVER FOREIGN VOLUNTARY ASSOCIATIONS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 2 of number 119 of the special acts of 1893 is
4 amended to read as follows (*Effective from passage and applicable to the*
5 *corporation's objects, purposes and activities whether carried on before, on or*
6 *after the effective date of this section*):

7 [The object for which this corporation is created is to establish and
8 maintain an asylum, infirmary, hospital, and home for the aged,
9 imbecile, crippled, and indigent members of the Independent Order of

10 Odd Fellows holding membership therein, and their wives, widows,
11 and orphan children, and to raise an endowment or fund by
12 contributions, voluntary tax on the members of the order, donations,
13 devises, and bequests, the income, rents, and profits of which shall be
14 applied to the support and maintenance of said home.] This
15 corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for
16 charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section
17 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or any
18 corresponding provision of any internal revenue law, to meet the
19 needs of elderly, disabled and/or infirm persons for housing, health
20 care and financial security and/or to provide day care services to
21 children and/or adults, and in furtherance of the foregoing purposes
22 and subject to the limitations of the Certificate of Incorporation of this
23 corporation, to engage in any lawful act or activity for which
24 corporations may be formed under the Connecticut Revised Nonstock
25 Corporation Act, chapter 602 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as
26 revised or replaced from time to time.

27 Sec. 502. Section 3 of number 119 of the special acts of 1893, as
28 amended by number 460 of the special acts of 1925, number 452 of the
29 special acts of 1943, number 243 of the special acts of 1953, special act
30 73-28 and section 1 of special act 82-35, is amended to read as follows
31 (*Effective from passage and applicable to the corporation's objects, purposes*
32 *and activities whether carried on before, on or after the effective date of this*
33 *section*):

34 The estate, property and fund which may be held by said
35 corporation for the uses and purposes herein before expressed shall,
36 with the rents, income and profits thereof, be exempted from all
37 taxation. [provided the real and personal estate held at any one time by
38 said corporation shall not amount to more than ten million dollars in
39 value.]"
