**"AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRONIC PAYMENT OF CERTAIN
COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE FEES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 1-1h of the general statutes, as
4 amended by section 27 of public act 03-4 of the June 30 special session,
5 is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
6 *from passage*):

7 (a) Any person who does not possess a valid motor vehicle
8 operator's license may apply to the Department of Motor Vehicles for
9 an identity card. The application for an identity card shall be
10 accompanied by the birth certificate of the applicant or a certificate of
11 identification of the applicant issued and authorized for such use by
12 the Department of Correction. Such application shall include: (1) The
13 applicant's name; (2) the applicant's address; (3) whether the address is
14 permanent or temporary; (4) the applicant's birthdate; (5) notice to the
15 applicant that false statements on such application are punishable
16 under section 53a-157b; and (6) such other pertinent information as the

17 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles deems necessary. A fee of ten* dollars
18 shall be paid to the department upon issuance to the applicant of an
19 identity card which contains a picture of the applicant and specifies the
20 applicant's height, sex and eye color. The applicant shall sign the
21 application in the presence of an official of the department. The
22 commissioner may waive the ten-dollar* fee for any applicant who has
23 voluntarily surrendered such applicant's motor vehicle operator's
24 license or whose license has been refused by the commissioner
25 pursuant to subdivision (4) of subsection (e) of section 14-36, as
26 amended. Application for an identity card may be made at any
27 location where an application for, or renewal of, a motor vehicle
28 operator's license may be made."
