**"AN ACT CONCERNING AUTHORIZATION OF STATE GRANT COMMITMENTS FOR SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECTS, CONCERNING URBAN ACTION FUNDS FOR LIBRARIES, SOIL REMEDIATION OF A PLAYING FIELD AND CONNECTION OF A WATER LINE TO A SCHOOL, AND CONCERNING SCHOOL NURSES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of  
4 subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of section 10-286 of the general  
5 statutes, as amended, or any regulation adopted by the State Board of  
6 Education concerning projected enrollment for a school building  
7 project, the town of New Haven may increase the projected enrollment

8 of the alteration project (Project Number 093-0319 A/RR) at Fair  
9 Haven Middle School to 930, the New Fair Haven K-8 School (Project  
10 Number 093-0317 N) to 690, and the New Jackie Robinson  
11 Replacement School (Project Number 093-0329 N) to 700."
