**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BOND COMMISSION."**

1 Strike section 501 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (c) of section 3-20 of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*  
5 *passage*):

6 (c) There is established the State Bond Commission, which shall  
7 consist of: the Governor, the Treasurer, the Comptroller, the Attorney  
8 General, the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management and the  
9 Commissioner of Public Works, each of whom may designate a deputy  
10 to represent him or her as a member at meetings of the State Bond  
11 Commission with full powers to act and vote [in] on his or her behalf;  
12 [, and] the cochairpersons and the ranking minority members of the  
13 joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance

14 of matters relating to state finance, revenue and bonding, each of  
15 whom may designate another member of said joint standing  
16 committee, who is not a member of the State Bond Commission, to  
17 represent him or her as a member at meetings of the State Bond  
18 Commission with full powers to act and vote [in] on his or her behalf;  
19 one member of the House of Representatives appointed by the speaker  
20 of the House of Representatives and one member of the Senate  
21 appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate. The members of  
22 said commission shall serve without compensation."
